<b>Graduate Award \$1000</b> – will be awarded to the student who has won the STAY Award each of their Grade 9, 10, 11, 12 school years. The Graduate Award is determined by historical record of the STAY Awards and determined by the SEED Committee. No application is required.			

### Rules for Application and Selection of Award Winners

1. Student applicant must apply for the STAY in School Awards using the 2021-22 application form and attaching their final 2021-22 report card or Ontario Secondary Transcript in a legible format.
2. Student applicant must be a Six Nations band member.
3. Student applicant must have been in full-time attendance during the 2021-22 school year.
4. Applications must be received at the address on the application form by September 30, 2022. Applications will be accepted if digitally verified sent or post-marked by September 30, 2022. Original documentation may be required to determine eligibility for award should any discrepancy exist in e-mailed or photocopied documents.
5. The SEED steering committee, made up of representatives from Imperial Oil and Six Nations, will be determined the winners based on the criteria herein.
6. Minimum average for consideration is 75%. The average is found using the following formula:  $(\text{math grade} + \text{science grade})/2$ .
7. If there are no applicants/winners for a category, that award money will be reallocated to the other categories or to Honourable Mention awards at the discretion of the SEED Committee.
8. Winners will be notified as soon as possible by email to the parent/guardian or to the student if over 18.
9. Award certificates and monetary winnings will be presented to winners at Six Nations Elected Council Student Recognition event in the Fall 2022/Winter 2023. Details will follow.
10. Consideration will be given to those students who attend a school delivering the Ontario Ministry of Education curriculum.
